The festival season gets off to a quick start with several events this month. The International Bar-B-Que Festival in Owensboro, KY is May 10 and 11. Get all the details at <http://www.bbqfest.com/>. The Lake Cumberland Blues, Boats & BBQ Fest in Jamestown, KY has moved from late August to Saturday, May 11 this year. The day long show features several acts including the Inner City Blues Band, da Mudcats, Deborah Renee & Two Weeks Old, Them Bones and more. Dog House Kitchen will play at this year's Old Louisville SpringFest on Saturday, May 18. Their full, two-day schedule can be found at <http://www.oldlouisvillespringfest.org/>. Pitt Academy will host their 29th annual Bar-B-Q on Saturday, May 18. The free blues tent will be back and this year has The KingBees and Little T&A. The music starts at 5:00 pm. A new blues festival begins in Elizabethtown, KY on Saturday, May 25. The BBQ, Blues & Bikes festival will set up in downtown E'town and the promoters expect to have more than 3,000 motorcycles show up for the event. Music will be provided by One Shot Johnny, Lamont Gillispie & 100 Proof, D Man & the Alley Hounds and The Blooze Brothers band from Chicago. Their website is <http://www.bbqbluesfest.com/>. Be sure to stop by the KBS booth and say hello. The Blues Between the Bridges festival returns to Lexington on Sunday, May 26. Acts include Tee Dee Young, Robbie Bartlett, RC & the Nightshades, Sofa King Deluxe and the G. Busy Blues Revue. The month ends with both the Portland Festival and the 4th Annual Germantown Schnitzelburg Blues Festival (GSBF) on Friday, May 31 and Saturday, June 1.

See the ad in this issue of *Blues News* for info on the GSBF and be sure to pick up a t-shirt featuring local bass player Jimmy Brown on the front.

Notable shows this month include several blues gigs on Derby Eve and Derby Day. Check out the blues calendar on page 10 for the two-day lineup. The Madison Theater in Covington, KY will have Delbert McClinton and G. Miles & the Hitmen on Friday, May 10. Grammy winner McClinton has made over 40 albums and was inducted into the Texas Heritage Songwriters Hall of Fame in 2011. The Kokomo, IN band Mike Milligan & Steam Shovel return to Stevie Ray's for the first time in several years on May 10. The bar on Main Street will also have Studebaker John & the Hawks from Chicago on Friday, May 17. The California band the Devil Makes Three plays a unique mix of blues, folk and punk and will be at Headliners Music Hall on Saturday, May 11. The Kansas City, MO blues and jazz band Grand Marquis will have a CD release party at Jim Porter's on Friday, May 17. The Belterra Casino in Florence, IN will have a day of barbecue, craft beers and blues from the Stacy Mitchhart Band on Saturday, May 18. That event begins at 6:00 pm and ends at midnight. The Charles Walker Band returns to the Hideaway Saloon on Sunday, May 26. The blues, soul and funk band from Milwaukee always put on a good show featuring mostly original music. The Beat Daddys round out the month with a two day appearance at the Chick Ridge Bike Rally in Hardinsburg, KY on May 30 and 31.

The deadline is approaching for bands to get their applications into the KBS for this year's blues competition. Applications must be received no later than Monday, May 6. Check out the KBS Blues Challenge advertisement in this issue of *Blues News*. The winning band receives \$1,500, local studio recording time from Alfresco Place, will be booked for another show in 2013 and will represent the KBS at the International Blues Challenge in 2014. The band contest is Sunday, June 2 at Stevie Ray's.

We've only received a few responses to our survey in last month's newsletter. Your help is needed to determine the direction of the KBS in the future. Please take two minutes to let us know what you think about the blues in our community. The survey is also available online at kbsblues.org/survey.htm.

The KBS would like to extend our thanks to Dale Cashion. Dale recently resigned as Development Director for the KBS but while he held that position, he was instrumental in getting Four Roses Bourbon as the major KBS Blues Challenge sponsor. We wish Dale continued success and be sure to check out his band The Bluesbenders when they are playing around town. We are looking for a new Development Director. Congratulations go out to Louisville native Greg Martin and his band The Kentucky Headhunters. They were inducted into the Kentucky Music Hall of Fame on Friday, April 12. The other 2013 inductees were Steven Curtis Chapman, Exile, Skeeter Davis, The Hilltoppers, Old Joe Clark and Emory & Linda Martin. Past inductees include Loretta Lynn, Patty Loveless, Dwight Yoakam, Crystal Gayle, Tom T. Hall and Bill Monroe among others.

After more than 13 years in business, Joey G's in Madison, IN announced their closing on April 1. Joey Gayles, the owner of both the House-O-Hits Record Store and his namesake nightclub in Madison, passed away on October 27 of last year. Joey was a longtime supporter of the arts and music scene in the area and his presence will be missed. Rest in peace, Joey G and thank you.

New Music Reviews!



Jake Lear
Diamonds and Stones
Self-Produced

This Vermont born, Memphis resident's trio has released this, his second CD on his own label. After giving the CD a listen, I began to wonder why I haven't heard the first CD. Lear definitely has the talent and originality to make a mark for himself. His guitar style is very distinctive, original and with catchy riffs. Those riffs are composed of chords as much as single notes.

There are 10 songs on the CD, all originals except for "Jack O' Diamonds" by John Lee Hooker, and "Work, Work, Work" by Junior Wells. If you like this Junior Wells song, you will surely like this version of it, even for one who thinks no one can do it better than Junior. One or two of the songs will remind the listener of Moreland and Arbuckle, but make no mistake about it, these songs are not copies of any other artist's styles. I have listened to this CD probably 20 times and I cannot find the words to describe it. That is not to say it is bad, in fact the converse is true (it may in fact be an indication of the writing capability of the author). The guitar is the center piece of the music with a reverb drenched mostly clean sound with only a little over-drive to give it a little more punch. The vocals are good too, but I must admit, I did not listen to the lyrics until just before writing this review as I was drawn more to the distinctive guitar.

I would highly recommend this CD. The songs are good, the musicianship is good by all three artists and it is like a breath of fresh air from some of the other releases I have recently heard by better known artists. The CD is available from CD Baby. You can find more info at www.jakelear.com.

**Long Tall Deb
Raise Your Hands
Self-Produced**

With a big, clear voice, mostly original material, well-known guest artists and good production quality, Long Tall Deb has released a CD which for the most part touches around the edges of the blues - but when she goes for it, she really digs in.

Authoring or co-writing 10 of the 12 tracks, Deb takes a funk and roots approach to some of the songs, and even explores country-rock-n-roots on occasion. Her west-Texas drawl, which gives evidence of her El Paso origin, is allowed to always be out front - even with several luminary guest artists making appearances and significant contributions on this recording (Damon Fowler, JP Soars, Bart Walker, Victor Wainwright, Reese Wynans and the Roomful of Blues Horns). Dave Clo and Mark Puskarich do a very good keeping things in balance and the sound crystal clear. And throughout, guest lead and background singer Nikki Scott and support vocalist Michelle Swift do an excellent job!

Although not all the songs can be labeled pure blues, that doesn't mean they don't stand out. Track 3 ("Train to Tucson" - a country-roots tune) has some wicked slide guitar in the mix, although it's not apparent from the liner notes just which of the three guitarists playing on this number is actually using the slide (Colin John, Sean Carney, or the aforementioned Dave Clo).

The strongest blues elements (at least instrumentally and melodically) come from tracks 7 ("Married to the Blues") onward towards the end of the song list. Track 11 ("To Find His Home") begins with a really good acoustic slide intro then revs up into a full-out gospel-esque shouter led by organist Reese Wynans and what sounds like a full choir. The final track is really nice: a sultry, jazz/blues number featuring Deb's voice and John Popovich on piano.

As with so many recordings and recording artists these days, pigeon-holing them into a single specific genre with tight boundaries is simply not possible. So, the jury is out as to whether this CD could technically be placed in the "blues" bin. One thing for sure: it's very good!

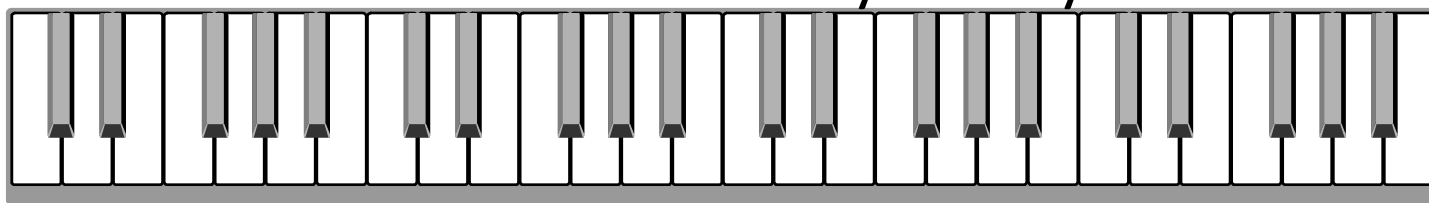
